The show is produced by Angel Flight East and all funds raised support this volunteer organization, providing expense-paid flights for patients needing medical care, but who lack the financial resources to travel commercially or who have a condition making it impossible to use public transportation. Club Manager Ron Ross is involved with the show.

Spectacular weather (again!) blessed the 23rd annual Wings 'N Wheels Show on Sept. 7th. This show is especially notable, as it combines contemporary to vintage aircraft and autos into an amazing display. It is easily the most colorful of car shows, as the aerodynamic lines of the aircraft contrast with the wide array of spectacular automobiles.

...and the New Hope Auto Show 2013 Where Our Region *Shines*

One of the shows that draws many of our members each year is the New Hope, PA Auto Show. This year was no exception, as no less than a dozen of our members attended along with their cars. Club Breakfasts Return

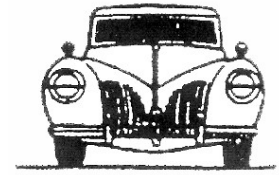
