Lincolns and Continentals in the Brandywine Valley LCOC Eastern National Meet June 10-14, 2015

The Philadelphia Region issues you this special invitation to join all our national members and guests to the 2015 Eastern National Meet in the lovely Brandywine Valley of Southeastern Pennsylvania.

The Brandywine Valley is rich in history. George Washington's Continental Army fought the Battle of Brandywine Creek (Sept. 11, 1777) in the very valley where you will be staying. This Revolutionary War battlefield is only a few miles from our hotel. The Continentals lost the battle and the City of Philadelphia, then the capitol of the United States, and fell back to an encampment at Valley Forge.



Our hotel for this Meet is the Wyndham Garden. It is in Glen Mills, Pennsylvania. If you go on the Wyndham web site it will be identified as being in Wilmington, Delaware. Glen Mills is on US Route 1 near the Delaware state line. The address is 1110 Baltimore Pike, Glen Mills, PA 19342, Phone (866) 460-7456, toll free. The hotel consists of 136 rooms with large parking area (with security) to be set aside for us. Parking includes trailer space. You will enjoy LCD TV with satellite programming, complimentary wireless internet, private baths with shower tubs and hair dryers - also a night club, outdoor pool, and fitness room arcade/game room. Room rates are a reasonable \$109 per night which includes breakfast. Taxes are in addition to this rate. Regular rate is \$160. Be sure to mention Lincoln Club for the \$109 rate. You must reserve your room

before May 1, 2015. This rate will hold for your entire stay if you book early – there are many sights to see and you will be only a short drive or train ride to Philadelphia.



We have arranged a variety of tours and a Thursday luncheon at the award winning Mendenhall Inn. The Thursday morning tour will be to the Magic Age of Steam, a Victorian Mansion which boasts a Stanley Steamer car collection.



Thursday afternoon features the tour of E.I. Dupont's 157 room mansion known as Winterthur including its grounds and gardens.



All tours are to places near the hotel as is the Mendenhall Inn, so your collector Lincolns and Continentals can easily make the runs. The terrain is gently rolling. A tour of Longwood Gardens is set for Friday afternoon. The grounds, gardens and fountains here are known world-wide for their magnificence. You may come and go here (just a few miles down Route 1) as often as you wish, leaving more than adequate time for judging your car on the Meet field.

Local attractions include. Chadds Ford Winery, the Mushroom Museum (Kennett Square) and the Brandywine River Museum featuring the works of the internationally known

Wyeth family of artists, N.C., Andrew and Jamie, located in a 19th century grist mill on the banks of the Brandywine Creek at Chadds Ford. Tours of the Wyeth house can be arranged thru the museum which can include Andrew Wyeth's own studio.

For adventurous types the City of Philadelphia, with its Constitution Center, Independence Hall, Betsy Ross House, Philadelphia Museum of Art, Franklin Institute and many other attractions in the City are very close by car or by SEPTA regional rail. The hotel can give you information about SEPTA, which will take you directly into center City Philadelphia.



There is so much available in this historic area that you may want to lengthen your stay either before or after the Meet since our hotel will hold the room rate if you book early.

If you print the registration form and fill it in by hand, US Mail it with your check for applicable charges to Michael Rigg at the address above.

Any Lincoln or Continental to be judged must be registered not later than May 26, 2015. We suggest you register your car, whether to be judged or not, at the same time you reserve your room at the hotel, i.e. before May 1, 2015.

Don't forget to order your Meet shirt and hat when you fill out your registration form.
