

Over the years, I've had many old Lincolns ('40 Zephyr Continental Cabriolet in '95, '41 Continental Coupe in '80, '41 Continental Cabriolet in '92 all of which I still own today) and many others. I have also owned Model A's since 1970 and been a member of the local Model A Club since 1970. We currently have a 1930 Model A Tudor purchased in 1984.

I had automotive training starting in 1969 and was ASE Certified when that program became available. Started working as a Mechanic for the City of Cincinnati working in their many different shops and ending up in Fire Apparatus.
