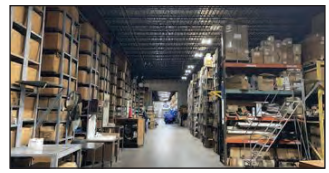

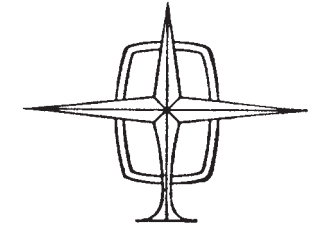

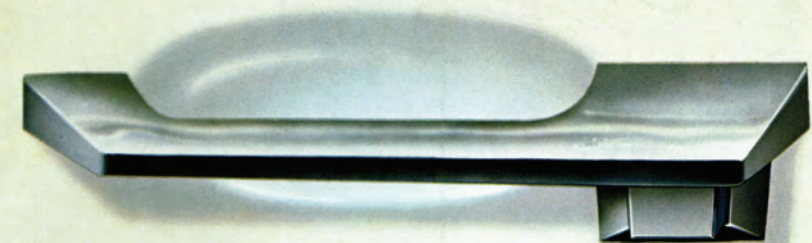

Tours of Union Terminal & Music Hall

Join fellow LCOC members for tours of Cincinnati's Union Terminal and Music Hall. One of the last great American train stations built, Union Terminal is a local icon and one of the most widely regarded examples of the art deco style. It opened in 1933.



Music Hall, built in 1878, designated a National Historic Landmark in 1975, and renovated in 2017, is among the city's most recognizable buildings.
